What is the Indigenous Summer Student Program?

The Indigenous Summer Student Program (ISSP) is an onboarding program with a mentoring element for Indigenous students working at the Canadian Food Inspection Agency during the spring and summer.

What does the program entail?

- Mentorship from an Indigenous CFIA employee
- Cultural events with Indigenous students, sharing circles, skills workshops and networking opportunities
- Support from the CFIA's Indigenous Employee network—the National Indigenous Advisory Circle

Besides the part-time or full time work at your placement, you will have opportunities to participate in skill building workshops as well as cultural Indigenous events and training, and network opportunities through the spring/summer. Your ISSP mentor will be a CFIA Indigenous employee and member of the National Indigenous Advisory Circle (NIAC).

What do I need to apply for the Indigenous Summer Student (ISSP) program?

You need to be either a high school student who will be attending college or university in September or a student currently attending college or university.

To be eligible for this program, you also need to self-identify as Indigenous (First Nation, Métis or Inuit).
