IV. VETERINARY CERTIFICATION

, the undersigned licensed veterinarian certify that the animal(s) identified I. above in the Part I of the sanitary certificate:

The animal(s) has/have been vaccinated against Rabies with an inactivated virus vaccine, no less than sixty (60) 1. days and no more than one (1) year prior to departure. In the case of primary vaccination, the animal(s) was/were at least ninety (90) days old when it was vaccinated. In the case of a booster vaccination, the animal was vaccinated against rabies not more than one (1) year prior to export. If the animal was vaccinated twice, these rabies vaccines were administered more than thirty (30) days apart.
