Overview of the roles and responsibilities when using Recognition of Export Grain Analysis by **Authorized Laboratories (REGAL) program**

Grain shipments under the REGAL program include whole grains (not intended for planting), split dicots or grains that have the seed coat or hull removed

EXPORTERS

- Use an approved sampler
- Communicate to the sampler the tests required to meet the importing country's requirements
- When required, clarify and respond to questions from the REGAL authorized laboratory regarding testing requirements
- Ensure grains to be tested are whole grains (not intended for planting), split dicots or grains that have the seed coat or hull removed
- Arrange courier service for sample shipment to the preferred REGAL laboratorv
- Submit to the CEIA:
- a copy of the sample label CGC bulk vessel label (for bulk vessel shipments) or copy of sample submission form (for containerized or railcar shipments)
- report of analysis
- phytosanitary certificate application

SAMPLER

- Ensure minimum 1kg for testing
- Communicate to the authorized REGAL laboratory the tests required to be completed
- Canadian Grain Commission for Bulk Vessel Shipments:
- send sample and copy of CGC bulk vessel label to REGAL laboratory
- Samplers for Containerized or Railcar shipments:
- Canadian Grain Sampling Program Sampler: send sample and sample submission form to REGAL laboratory
- CFIA Sampler: the inspector will provide the sealed sample back to the processor/exporter to send via courier to the REGAL laboratory with a completed CGSP form

AUTHORIZED REGAL LABORATORIES

- Contact exporter or local CFIA office if weed seed testing request is unclear
- Report results for only those tests requested by the exporter
- Provide copies of report of analysis¹ CGC bulk vessel label or submission form (for containerized or railcar shipments) to exporter
- Provide same information to the CFIA when a sample meets the detection criteria

¹ Sample test results will indicate detected or not detected for the destination country's weed seed requirements. Not tested will be used when a weed seed test was not conducted.

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CFIA

- Complete testing for samples outside REGAL program scope (testing for diseases, weed seeds outside the REGAL program, seed shipments for propagation, and crushed ground grains)
- Interpret laboratory results provided in support of phytosanitary certification
- Send completed phytosanitary certificate to exporter OR contact exporter for more information
- Initiate follow-up action, as required
